Youth Day Program

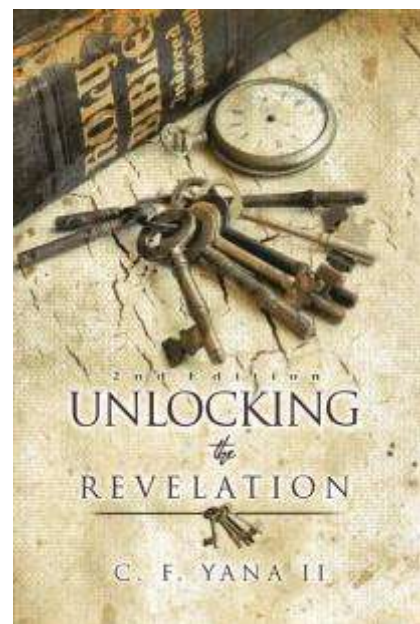
