Divorce

(*Emp. added*)

Mal 2:13 And this have ye done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that He regardeth not the offering any more, or receiveth *it* with good will at your hand. 14 Yet ye say, Wherefore? Because the LORD hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, against whom thou hast dealt treacherously: yet is she thy companion, and the wife of thy covenant. 15 And did not He make one? Yet had He the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That He might seek a godly seed*. Therefore take heed to your spirit (*think about it!*), and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth. 16 For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that He **hateth putting away**: for *one* covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously. (*Emp. added*)

**Statistics show that godly marriages, for the most part, produce godly offspring.*

Abortion

"Adam's rib + Satan's fib = women's lib". (*unknown origin*)

Because Eve was the first to partake of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, women have since had pain in childbearing. And since she was originally created as Adam's "help meet" and forgot her "place" as such, God reminded her of it in Gen 3:16.

 On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court of the United States ruled, in a Texas case entitled *Roe, et al. v. (Justice William Rehnquist, dissenting) This case set the nation on a course of legalized abortion in unimaginable numbers. Over the first fifteen years after the Court's decision, an average of 1,500,000 babies annually were aborted under the protection of *Roe v. Wade*. Doctors, hospitals and clinics all were faced with the ethical and moral question of whether or not to allow the legal procedure to be done or not.

**In this case at least three sets of hands have shed innocent blood; the mother having the abortion, the father who agrees to it and the physician who performs it (not to mention those who aid him in doing so).*

Rom 13:4 For he (*ruler-Gk.758-magistrate*) is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to *execute* wrath upon him that doeth evil (*even capital punishment*). 5 Wherefore *ye* must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. 6 For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing.

Exo 21:22 If men strive, and **hurt a woman with child**, so **that her fruit depart from her**, and yet no mischief follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges *determine*. 23 And **if *any* mischief follow**, then thou shalt give **life for life**, 24 Eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, 25 Burning for burning, wound for wound, stripe for stripe. (*Emp. added*)

This passage alone should be enough to settle the argument of whether or not the unborn are to be protected.

The devil loves to ice the cake of sin with a cover-up; those contemplating an abortion should resist him and come clean. He would love to add murder to the sin of fornication, but God counsels birth and even the possibility of adoption when necessary.

In God's Plan:

The Responsibility of Husbands: MAN UP!

Col 3:19 Husbands, love *your* wives, and be not bitter against them.

Pro 18:22 *Whoso* findeth a wife findeth a good *thing*, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

1Pe 3:7 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with *them* according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the (*physically*) weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

The Responsibility of Fathers

Eph 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Pro 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Deu 11:18 Therefore shall ye lay up these My words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. 19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. 20 And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates: 21 That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.

Col 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children *to anger*, lest they be discouraged.

Pro 22:15 Foolishness *is* bound in the heart of a child; *but* the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

One of the qualifications to be an elder has to do with how he leads his own family.

1Ti 3:4 One that ruleth (*Gk.4291-to stand before, preside*) well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity (*Gk.4587-venerableness [Webster- respect]*); 5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

The Responsibility of Wives: **WOMAN UP!**

Col 3:18 Wives, submit yourselves (*Gk.5293-be under obedience*) unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.

Pro 31:10 Who can find a virtuous (*Heb.2428-force, strong*) [Webster: chaste; descent, modest] woman? for her price is far above rubies. 11 The heart (*Heb.3820-intelect*) of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. 12 She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life.

Society should **not** define the strength of womanhood!

1Pe 3:1 Likewise, ye wives, *be* in subjection to your own husbands; that, **if any obey not the word**, they also may **without the word be won by the conversation of the wives**; 2 While they behold your chaste conversation (*Gk.391-behavior*) coupled with fear. (*Emp. added*)

Any woman who feels she has the right to be over her husband is weak and has given in to the "fib" of Satan. **As the family goes, so goes the nation!** A nation's downfall can be contributed to the family structure.

The Responsibility to Grandmothers

1Ti 5:3 Honour widows that are widows indeed.⁴ But if any widow have children or nephews (*Gk.1549-descendant, grandchild, nephew*), let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to requite (*repay*) their parents (*Gk.4269-ancestor, [grand] parent*): for that is good and acceptable before God.

Tit 2:3 The aged women likewise, that *they be* in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; 4 That they may **teach the young women** to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, 5 *To be* discreet, chaste, keepers at home*, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. (*Emp. added*)

*Keepers of the home- Whether she works outside the home or not, her focus is to be on her place as the one who keeps the home front. The virtuous woman of Prov 31 worked outside the home but her focus was on the home. Her focus wasn't on a career unless it allowed her to remain focused on her family and not on her self!

The Responsibility of Children to Parents/ Parents to Children

2Co 12:14 Behold, the third time I am ready to come to you; and I will not be burdensome to you: for I seek not yours, but you: for **the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.** (*Emp. added*)

Eph 6:1 Children, **obey your parents** in the Lord: for this is right. 2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) 3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. (*Emp. added*)

Col 3:20 Children, obey *your* parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

Psa 127:3 Lo, children *are* an heritage of the LORD: *and* the fruit of the womb *is* His reward. 4 **As arrows** *are* in the hand of a mighty man; so *are* children of the youth. 5 Happy *is* the man that hath his **quiver full of them:** they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate. (*Emp. added*)

SO the family to be as God would have it then would be one where:

1. husband (*male*) and wife (*female*) are **scripturally** married. (*not "shaking up"*)
2. "family planning" doesn't include abortion in the process!
3. taking care of parents, grandparents who are unable to take care of themselves is the norm.
4. parents are helping their children financially, or otherwise, to get on their feet.
5. children have respect for their parents.
6. grandmothers (*and grandfathers*) have input.
7. God is the center of every decision, teaching and action.
