

The Most Beautiful Woman in the World

Gen 2:21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made He a woman, and brought her unto the man. 23 And Adam said, This *is* now **bone of my bones**, and **flesh of my flesh**: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

- Was Eve the most beautiful woman? After all she was the first woman to exist.

Est 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, (this *is* Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, *over* an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:) 2 *That* in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which *was* in Shushan the palace, 3 In the third year of his reign, he made a feast unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, *being* before him: 4 When he shewed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the honour of his excellent majesty many days, *even* an hundred and fourscore days. 5 And when these days were expired, the king made a feast unto all the people that were present in Shushan the palace, both unto great and small, seven days, in the court of the garden of the king's palace; 6 *Where were* white, green, and blue, *hangings*, fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds *were of* gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble. 7 And they gave *them* drink in vessels of gold, (the vessels being diverse one from another,) and royal wine in abundance, according to the state of the king. 8 And the drinking *was* according to the law; none did compel: for so the king had appointed to all the officers of his house, that they should do according to every man's pleasure. 9 Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women *in* the royal house which *belonged* to king Ahasuerus. 10 On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king, 11 To bring **Vashti** the queen before the king with the crown royal, **to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on.** 12 But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by *his* chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

- The king was drunk and a bit temperamental. And besides, Vashti wounded his pride.

Est 1:13 Then the king said to the wise men...

Est 1:15 What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law...?

Est 1:19 If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Est 2:4 And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

Est 2:15 ... And Esther obtained favour in the sight of all them that looked upon her.

Est 2:17 And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

- Esther surpassed the beauty of Vashti but was SHE the most beautiful woman in the world?

There have been artists over the centuries who have painted portraits of women in their day that would have been considered very beautiful. When we look at those paintings in museums and other places and then think about what's considered beautiful today, we wouldn't be very impressed. Styles and tastes have changed with each generation. Remember the almost anorexic model Twiggy?

WHO?

Not a figment of imagination.

Description:

- She, like Eve, is multi-racial. *(Have you noticed that the portrait of Betty Crocker has changed to represent a cross section of the world's women.)* She comes from a diversified background.

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a **great multitude**, which no man could number, **of all nations**, and **kindreds**, and **people**, and **tongues**, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, **clothed with white robes**, and palms in their hands;

WHAT?

A virgin:

2Co 11:2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one Husband, that I may present *you as* a **chaste virgin** to Christ.

A Bride:

Rev 19:6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. 7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His **wife** hath made herself ready. 8 And to her was granted that she should be **arrayed in fine linen**, clean and white: for the fine linen is **the righteousness of saints**. 9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed *are* they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

Rev 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. 2 And I John saw the holy city, new

Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a **bride** adorned for her husband.

A Kingdom:

Dan 2:44 And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a **kingdom**, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, *but* it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.

Mat 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**

Col 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: **13** Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and **hath translated us** into the **kingdom of His dear Son:**

A Mountain:

- *(This would be one adjective that husbands would not want to use to describe their wives unless they are in the mood to sleep in the dog house.)*

Isa 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the last days (*dispensation*), *that* the **mountain of the LORD'S house** (*the church*) shall be established in the **top** of the mountains, and shall be **exalted above** the hills; and **all nations** (*Rev 7:9*) shall flow unto it.

Heb 12:22 But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, **23** To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, **24** And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than *that of* Abel. **25** See that ye refuse not Him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him (*Moses*) that spake on earth, much more *shall not* we *escape*, if we turn away from Him that *speaketh* from heaven: **26** Whose voice then shook the earth: but now He hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven. **27** And this *word*, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. **28** Wherefore we **receiving a kingdom** (*Col 1:12*) which **cannot be moved** (*Dan 2:44*), let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: **29** For our God *is* a consuming fire.

The Body of Christ:

1Co 12:27 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

Eph 5:30 For we are members of His **body**, of His **flesh**, and of His **bones.** (*Gen 2:23*)

Rom 7:4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the **body of Christ**; that ye should be **married to another**, *even* to Him Who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

WHEN?

Zec 14:8 And it shall be **in that day**, *that* **living waters** shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

Joh 4:7 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, **Give Me to drink.** **8** (For His disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) **9** Then saith the woman of Samaria unto Him, How is it that Thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans. **10** Jesus answered and said unto her, **If thou knewest the gift of God, and Who it is that saith to thee, Give Me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of Him, and He would have given thee living water.**

Mar 1:14 Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, **15** And saying, **The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.**

Rev 12:1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: **2** And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

Rev 12:5 And she brought forth a man child, Who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and *to* His throne.

(Act 1:9 And when He had spoken these things, while they beheld, He was taken up; and a cloud received Him out of their sight.)

Rev 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, **Now is come** salvation, and strength, and the **kingdom** of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

- **The kingdom/bride of Christ came after Jesus ascended back to the right hand of God His father.**

Act 1:6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of Him, saying, Lord, wilt Thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel? **7** And He said unto them, **It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in His own power.** **8** **But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.**

Act 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they *(the twelve apostles)* were all with one accord in one place.

Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Act 2:14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all *ye* that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words:

Act 2:31 ... (*David*) seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that His soul was not left in hell (*Hades*), neither His flesh did see corruption. 33 Therefore being **by the right hand of God** exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost (*Dan 7*), He hath shed forth this (*the kingdom come*), which ye now see and hear.

WHERE?

Joh 18:36 Jesus answered, **My kingdom is not of this world:** if My kingdom were of this world, then would My servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is My kingdom **not from hence.**

Luk 17:20 And when He was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, He answered them and said, **The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:** 21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God **is within you.**

WHY?

What is her purpose?

Eph 3:9 ... to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, Who created all things by Jesus Christ: 10 **To the intent** that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly *places* might be known **by the church** the manifold wisdom of God, 11 According to the eternal purpose which He purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

Eph 5:27 That He might present it to Himself a glorious [*Who is the most beautiful woman in the world?*] (*Gk.1741-gorgeous*) church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Are you part of the most beautiful woman in the world? If not you can be. To be baptized into **Christ** is to put **Him** on as a wedding garment (*Mat 22*) thus to be part of **His** bride the church.
