

## The Next Day

Luk 22:1 Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover. 2 And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill Him; for they feared the people. 3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. 4 And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray Him unto them. 5 And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money. 6 And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray Him unto them in the absence of the multitude.

Thursday

Luk 22:7 Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the Passover must be killed. 8 And He sent Peter and John, saying, **Go and prepare us the Passover, that we may eat.** 9 And they said unto Him, Where wilt thou that we prepare? 10 And He said unto them, **Behold, when ye are entered into the city, there shall a man meet you, bearing a pitcher of water; follow him into the house where he entereth in.** 11 And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, **The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guest chamber, where I shall eat the Passover with My disciples?** 12 And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready. 13 And they went, and found as He had said unto them: and they made ready the Passover.

- A man...bearing a pitcher of water- With the foreknowledge of Deity, Jesus told Peter and John where in the city they would be at the exact time this servant of the one who owned the house which would have been ready to receive them for the Passover meal.

Luk 22:14 And when the hour was come, He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him.

Joh 13:2 And **supper being ended**, the devil having now **put into the heart** (*mind*) of Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*, to betray Him; 3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He was come from God, and went to God; 4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside His garments; and took a towel, and girded Himself. 5 After that He poured water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel wherewith He was girded.

Joh 13:12 So after He had washed their feet, and had taken His garments, and was set down again, He said unto them, **Know ye what I have done to you?**

Joh 13:15 **For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.**

Joh 13:21 When Jesus had thus said, He was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray Me.**

Joh 13:25 He (*John*) then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto Him, Lord, who is it? 26 Jesus answered, **He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it.** And when He had dipped the sop, He gave *it* to Judas Iscariot, *the son* of Simon. 27 And after the sop Satan **entered into him**. Then said Jesus unto him, **That thou doest, do quickly.**

Luk 22:35 And He said unto them, **When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye anything?** And they said, Nothing.

*Mat 10:9 Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses, 10 Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves (Gk.4464-a stick or*

*wand [as a cudgel] [Webster: cudgel- a short, thick stick or club; to beat with a cudgel]: for the workman is worthy of his meat. (They didn't need to defend themselves against beasts...yet.)*

Luk 22:36 Then said He unto them, **But now**, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that **hath no sword**, let him sell his garment, and **buy one**.

- There is much controversy over the idea of Jesus making reference to the apostles obtaining swords and the reason for it. He was preparing them for future dangers and not arming them against those who were shortly to take Him away to be crucified. As Paul stated in his letters, it seems he too went into areas where he would have had to defend himself, not against men but, against wild animals. Paul had to have faced similar situations as did Daniel.

*Dan 6:16 Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast him into the den of lions. Now the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God Whom thou servest continually, He will deliver thee.*

*1Co 15:32 If after the manner of men I have **fought with beasts** at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for tomorrow we die.*

*2Co 11:23 .., in **prisons more frequent, in deaths oft**.*

*2Co 11:26 .., in **perils in the wilderness**,..*

Luk 22:37 For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in Me, And He was reckoned among the transgressors: for the things concerning Me have an end. 38 And they said, Lord, behold, here *are* two swords. And He said unto them, **It is enough**.

Mar 14:26 And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.

Joh 18:1 When Jesus had spoken these words (*the Lord's prayer*), He went forth with His disciples over the brook Cedron (*Kidron*), where was a garden, into the which He entered, and His disciples. 2 And Judas also, which betrayed Him, knew the place: for Jesus oftentimes resorted thither with His disciples.

Mar 14:32 And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and He saith to His disciples, **Sit ye here, while I shall pray**.

Mar 14:37 And He cometh, and findeth them sleeping, and saith unto Peter, **Simon, sleepest thou? couldest not thou watch one hour?**

Mar 14:39 And again He went away, and prayed, and spake the same words. 40 And when He returned, He found them asleep again, (for their eyes were heavy,) neither wist they what to answer Him.

Mat 26:45 Then cometh He to His disciples, and saith unto them, **Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.** 46 **Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray Me.** 47 And while He yet spake, lo, Judas, one of the twelve, came, and with him a great multitude with **swords** and **staves**, from the chief priests and elders of the people.

*Joh 18:3* Judas then, having received a band of men and officers from the chief priests and Pharisees, cometh thither with lanterns and torches and **weapons**. (*swords & clubs*)

*Mar 14:46* And they laid their hands on Him, and took Him.

*Luk 22:49* When they which were about Him saw what would follow, they said unto Him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword? *50* And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear. *51* And Jesus answered and said, **Suffer ye thus far**. And He touched his ear, and healed him.

*Mat 26:52* Then said Jesus unto him, **Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.** *53* Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels? *54* But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be?

*Joh 18:11* Then said Jesus unto Peter, **Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which My Father hath given Me, shall I not drink it?**

*Mar 14:50* And they all forsook Him, and fled.

*Mar 14:53* And they led Jesus away to the high priest: and with him were assembled all the chief priests and the elders and the scribes.

- **Jesus did not sleep all night.**

The next day: Friday

*Luk 22:66* And **as soon as it was day**,.. (*sometime after 6 AM since their days started at 6*)

*Mar 15:1* ...straightway **in the morning** the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried *Him* away, and delivered *Him* to Pilate.

*Joh 18:28* ... from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and **it was early**;

*Mar 15:6* Now at *that* feast he (*Pilate*) released unto them one prisoner, whomsoever they desired. *7* And there was *one* named Barabbas, *which lay* bound with them that had made insurrection with him, who had committed murder in the insurrection.

*Mat 27:26* Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered *Him* to be crucified.

*Mar 15:22* And they bring Him unto the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.

*Mar 15:24* And when they had crucified Him, they parted His garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take. *25* And it was the **third hour** (*9 AM*), and they crucified Him.

*Luk 23:39* And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on Him, saying, If Thou be Christ, save Thyself and us. *40* But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou

fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation? 41 And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man hath done nothing amiss. 42 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when Thou comest into Thy kingdom. 43 And Jesus said unto him, **Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with Me in paradise.** 44 And it was about the **sixth hour** (*noon*), and there was a darkness over all the earth until the **ninth hour** (*3 PM*).

Mar 15:34 And at the **ninth hour** Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, **Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?** which is, being interpreted, My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?

Mar 15:37 And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost. 38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom. 39 And when the centurion, which stood over against Him, saw that He so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

Mar 15:42 And now **when the even was come**, because it was the preparation, that is, the **day before** the sabbath (*Friday*), 43 Joseph of Arimathaea, an honorable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus. 44 And Pilate marveled if He were already dead: and calling *unto him* the centurion, he asked him whether He had been any while dead. 45 And when he knew *it* of the centurion, he gave the body to Joseph. 46 And he bought fine linen, and took Him down, and wrapped Him in the linen, and laid Him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre. 47 And Mary Magdalene and Mary *the mother* of Joses beheld where He was laid.

The next day: Saturday (*the Sabbath*)

Exo 31:14 *Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it is holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people.* 15 *Six days (Sunday thru Friday) may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death.* 16 *Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant.*

Mat 27:62 Now **the next day**, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate, 63 Saying, Sir, we remember that that deceiver said, while He was yet alive, After **three days** I will rise again. 64 Command therefore that the sepulchre be made sure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night, and steal Him away, and say unto the people, He is risen from the dead: so the last error shall be worse than the first. 65 Pilate said unto them, Ye have a watch: go your way, make *it* as sure as ye can. 66 So they went, and made the sepulchre sure, sealing the stone, and setting a watch.

- During this time, **Jesus rested in Paradise**, the part of the **Hadean realm** where He told the repentant thief they would be together in. (*Lk 23:43*) *He did not go there an preach, as some would suppose the interpretation of 1 Pet 3:19 to mean.*

The next day: Sunday

Mat 16:18 *...I will build My church; and the gates of hell (Gk.86- Hades) shall not prevail against it.*

**Mar 16:1** And when the **sabbath was past**, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint Him. **2** And very **early in the morning the first day of the week**, they came unto the sepulchre **at the rising of the sun**.

**Mat 28:2** And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the (*an*) angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it. **3** His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow: **4** And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead *men*. **5** And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. **6** He is not here: for He is risen, **as He said**. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.

**Mar 16:5** And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted. **6** And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: He is risen; He is not here: behold the place where they laid Him. **7** But go your way, tell His disciples and Peter that He goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see Him, **as He said unto you**.

**Mar 16:9** Now when *Jesus* was risen **early the first day of the week**, He appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom He had cast seven devils. **10** *And* she went and told them that had been with Him, as they mourned and wept.

**Luk 24:13** And, behold, two of them went **that same day** to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs. **14** And they talked together of all these things which **had happened**.

**Joh 20:19** Then **the same day at evening**, being **the first day of the week**, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, **Peace be unto you**.

The Next Week

**Joh 20:26** And **after eight days** again His disciples were within, and Thomas with them: *then* came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, **Peace be unto you**.

**1Co 15:1** Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; **2** By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. **3** For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; **4** And that He was buried, and that He rose again **the third day** according to the scriptures: **5** And that He was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: **6** After that, He was seen of **above five hundred brethren at once**; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep. **7** After that, He was seen of James; then of all the apostles. **8** And **last of all** He was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

**Act 2:30** Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him (*David*), that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, He would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; **31** He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that His soul was not left in hell (*Hades*), neither His flesh did see corruption (*Gk.1312-decay*). **32** This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

**Act 2:36** Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, Whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. **37** Now when they heard *this*, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men *and* brethren, what shall we do? **38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name (*Gk.3686- authority*) of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. **39** For the promise (*Gk.1860- a divine assurance of good*) is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off (*Gk.3112- at a distance [from 3372-in place or time] [thus in the future], even* as many as the Lord our God shall call (*Gk.4341- invite*). **40** And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. **41** Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added *unto them* about three thousand souls.

**2Th 2:14** Whereunto He **called** (*Gk.2564- bid*) you **by** our **gospel**, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Today

**Heb 3:15** While it is said, Today if ye will hear His voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.

**Jas 4:14** Whereas ye know not what *shall be* on the morrow. For what *is* your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.

**Mat 6:33** **But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.** **34** **Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.**

- **Today** is the day of salvation, tomorrow may be too late. Christ invites everyone to join Him when He returns to receive His own. Will you be ready **on that day**?

**Hear: Romans 10:17** ..."faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."

**Believe: Heb 11:6** ..."for he that commeth to God must believe that He is"...

**Repent: Lk 13:3** ..."except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish."

**Confess: Mat 10:32** "Whosoever shall confess Me before men, him will I confess before My Father which is in Heaven."

**Be baptized: Acts 22:16** "And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

**Remain faithful: Rom 6:4** ..."even so we also should walk in newness of life."
